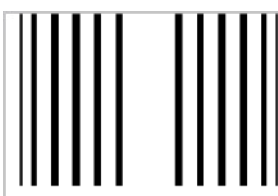

Running a business rarely gives us space to explore the questions that matter most. So let nature provide a unique space for your senior team to tackle strategy and sustainability challenges.

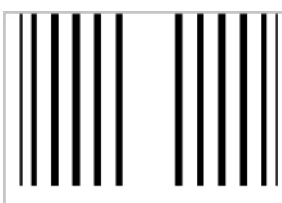
## Strategy Day in Nature

# No two days in nature are the same.

We've found that a mix of hands-on activities with learning & reflection works best. But we'll help you plan your day around what your team needs most. We take care of the important details, from transport to food, drink and tools. So your team can get the most from your day in nature.

- Transport pick-ups from Haywards Heath Station (regular trains from London & Brighton).
- A guided walk through the ancient woodland and introduction to the Wilderlands rewilding project.
- Hands-on activities helping to restore nature; with optional learning, storytelling and reflection sessions.
- Tea, coffee & snacks around the fire at our barn in the woods, plus a local & seasonal lunch made by local chefs using produce from nearby farms.
- Drop back at Haywards Heath Station or end the day at a local country pub.

# Hands-on activities

- **Restoring Wilderness.** Creating log piles for reptiles, clearing fences, sowing wildflower seeds, creating chestnut deer fences, making fire circles, clearing pathways.
- **Tree Planting** with Forests Without Frontiers (November to March). Take action against climate breakdown by planting trees to help restore ecosystems, boost biodiversity, and protect wildlife. Be part of the solution and leave a lasting environmental legacy.
- **Tree Tending** (Summer months). Maintaining and monitoring newly planted trees is vital for their survival. Ensuring they grow strong, protecting ecosystems and maximising environmental impact.



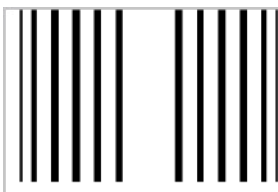
# Learning activities

- **Food & Medicine from Nature.** It's there, if we know where to look. Guided by some of Sussex's leading foragers and herbalists.
- **Tracking & Wildlife Identification.** Learn to spot who we share the woods with. Teachers & guides help you see 'how and who'.
- **Earth Painting.** Paint with local artist David St. Maur Sheil, using pigments and paint from the different earths in the woods.
- **Woodcraft.** Learn traditional skills with Jason Mossieri, creating houses for birds and viewing seats for us humans.
- **Wilderness Skills & Nature Crafts.** Fire making, working with deer skins, making natural cordage, den building, funghi identification.
- **Woodland Awareness Walk.** Delve into the mystery of the unseen, with woodsman and naturalist Steve Jones.
- **Pond Life.** Water makes life, in ways you'd never imagine. As told by one of Sussex's premier pond makers.
- **Primal Skills.** Learn how to work with flint, tan skins; and make string from plants or fire with a bow drill.
- **Songs in the Woods.** With Sam Lee, Mercury Prize-nominated folk singer/songwriter, renowned for singing to nature.
- **Venturing into the Unseen.** Step into an unfamiliar sensory world with Dr. Karis Petty. A world of listening, touching and imagining.

# Reflection & Storytelling

Give your team the time & space to explore their own reactions to the day. This can be framed (with questions or illustration) to incorporate both personal and work-related inspiration. With time to walk alone and reflect in the woods, and come back together to share what we've learned.

What's the shared story of our day? We have access to several accomplished storytellers who would recount an appropriate tale to go home with.

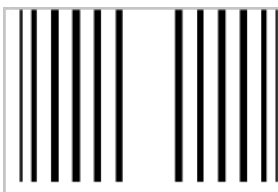

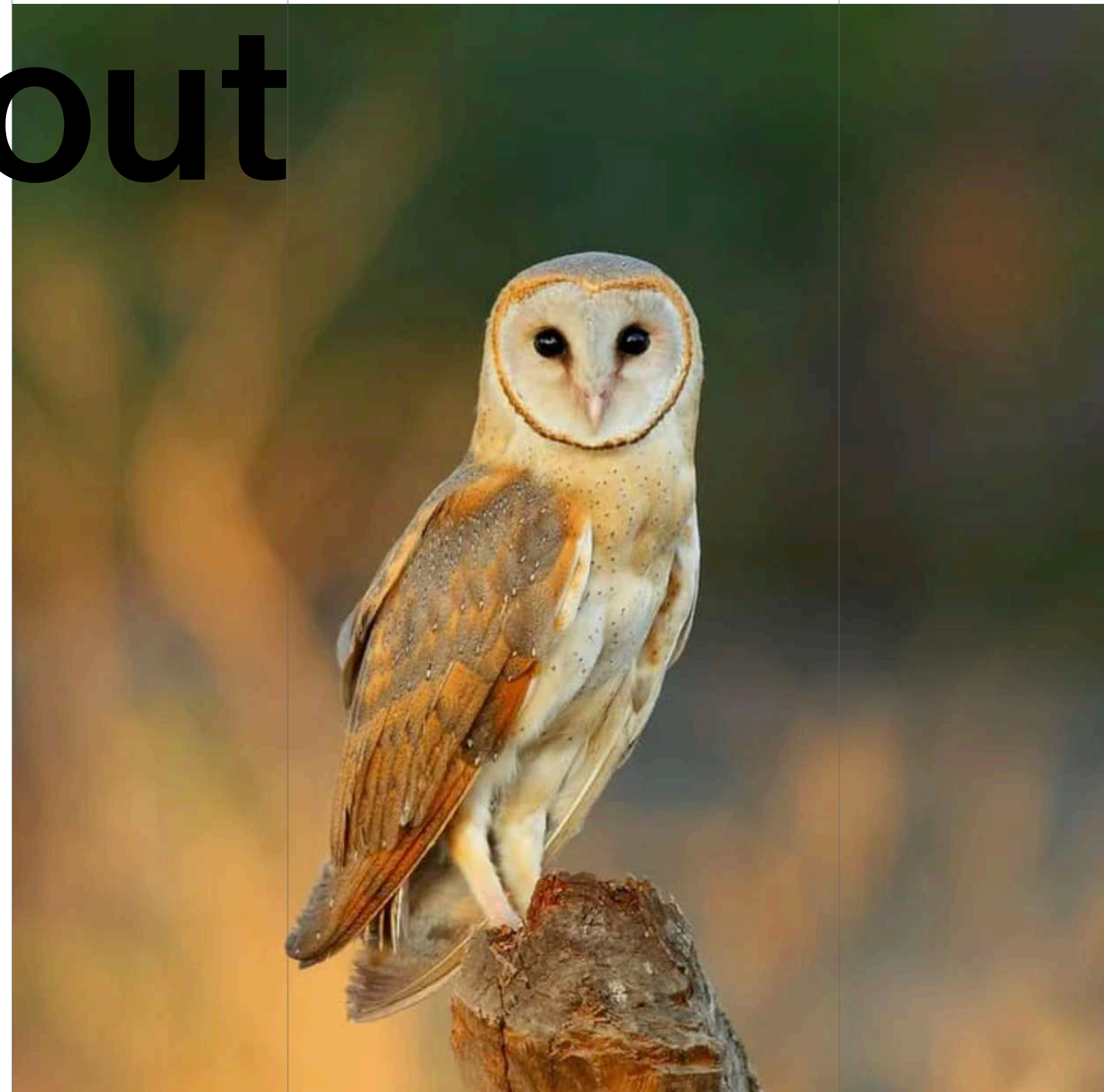

# Wilderlands

Bringing together 277 acres for nature and wildlife, **Wilderlands** is made up of 20 acres of 5 medieval meadows, 213 acres of ancient forest and another 44 acres of wild meadows in Sussex near Fletching.

The ancient woodland has varied habitats, including tributaries of the River Ouse, small streams and old ponds, with many different tree species.

Through the rewilding project of planting orchards, building ponds, restoring scrub, reinstating traditional hedgerows, letting wild flower meadows return, and the creation of a forest garden there is hope for Wilderlands to become a haven for vast species of wildlife, showing the wonder of the natural world.

Wilderlands is part of the **Weald to Waves** network. Working to establish a nature recovery corridor from the High Weald to the Sussex coasts.

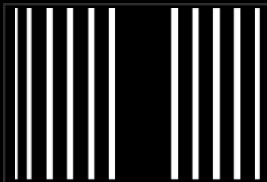
